<b>AAP707</b>	<b>Space Design</b>	<b>6.0 CP</b>	<b>9.0 ECTS</b>
Development and design of complicated architectural and spatial structure. Development of public centre in active urban environment.			
<b>ATM301</b>	<b>Drawing I (part II)</b>	<b>3.0 CP</b>	<b>4.5 ECTS</b>
The subject DRAWING III provides profound knowledge and skills in order to depict spatial environment by using a wide range of artistic means of expression and materials. The assignments in drawing are accomplished while working in urban environment and studio, rapidly and purposefully sketching from nature, working out detailed compositions and also working from imagination. A human figure is thoroughly studied in the context of surrounding environment.			
<b>ATM204</b>	<b>Painting (part I)</b>	<b>2.0 CP</b>	<b>3.0 ECTS</b>
The subject PAINTING teaches fundamentals of water-colour painting and colouristics in which students acquire necessary skills to be used in their future profession of an architect. The skills are acquired by doing practical work in water-colour medium: painting still-life groups, human figure and interior objects, as well as abstract compositions. The given assignments contain certain requirements for mastering colour, composition and technical methods of water-colour painting. The course of painting is followed by Summer practice where students concentrate on the principles of landscape painting.			
<b>ATM224</b>	<b>Book Design and Poster</b>	<b>4.0 CP</b>	<b>6.0 ECTS</b>
In the subject Book design and poster students master fundamentals of applied graphics and their compositional features by doing practical work, thus, gaining knowledge and skills for the appropriate application of the means of artistic expression in the solution of specified assignments. During the classes individual consultations and discussions with professors are available. Students work in the workshop as well as independently.			
<b>AAP306</b>	<b>Outdoor Furniture</b>	<b>2.0 CP</b>	<b>3.0 ECTS</b>
The specific features of outdoor furniture designing, its context with environment and connection with greenery and landscape architecture. Styles, expression, patterns.			
<b>AAP454</b>	<b>Architecture of Regional Landscape</b>	<b>2.0 CP</b>	<b>3.0 ECTS</b>
Landscape design component for environmental quality. Interrelation of landscaping, architecture and art. History of landscaping, concept of development in connection with joint disciplines, typology, basic compositional elements, systems for urban landscaping and greenery. Gardens and parks in the architectural structure of urban and rural areas.
